



I would like to nominate Professor Don Phillips for the title Emeritus Professor. Don has recently retired after a very long period of service to the University. Professor Hoogenraad the Head of School, School of Molecular Sciences is supportive of the nomination and has offered the following comments.

"Don has gone through the ranks from the time he was appointed in 1972 as a senior demonstrator to the point where he received a personal chair several years ago. In many ways, Don's research has matured in the last decade, where he has established himself as a genuine leading international player in the area of DNA adduct formation and understanding the way some of the most commonly used anti-cancer agents work.
