1. Department/School proposing the prize:

Philosophy Program - School of Communication, Arts and Critical Enquiry

2. Name of Prize:

Geoffrey John Blunden Essay Prize in Philosophy

3. Nature and value of Prize:

\$500

The Prize is to be awarded annually for the best essay by an undergraduate student on a topic concerned with applied ethics.

4. Method of Imparting Prize:

The Prize will be presented at the annual University Prize Giving ceremony in the year following submission of entries.

5. Name and address of donor:

6. Period for which prize is committed:

In the event that in a particular year no suitable essay is forthcoming, the retained sum will be available for a subsequent year thereby extending the initial five-year period of the Prize.

7. Eligibility:

The Prize will be open to all enrolled undergraduate students of La Trobe University whether part-time or full time, including honours students.

8. Criteria:

That the essay meet or exceed the Faculty of HUSS criteria for an 'A' essay at undergraduate level.

9. Special conditions, if any:

- o The Prize will be judged annually by a panel appointed by the Philosophy Program Coordinator from time to time.
- o Essays are to be of no more than 3000 words and may or may not have been submitted for assessment in a University course.
- o Only one essay may be submitted by a student in a given year, but there is no restriction on the number of times a student may enter or win the Prize.
- o At the discretion of the judges, there may be joint winners.

o Administration of the prize, including advertising, receipt of essays etc is to be in the hands of the Philosophy Program.
