Defence Export Controls Reminder

Are you planning to send research information or a technology overseas to another party? Could the technology or information, which is mainly intended for commercial purposes also be applied in a military capacity or in weapons development, commonly known as 'dual-use'? Does the research relate to a new security system, algorithm, bacteria, engineered composite material or enhanced acoustics software?

The research information may then be controlled.

There are many items that support information for a dual-use technology, such as drawings, blueprints, instructions, photographs, plans, diagrams, schematics and technical data - all of which are also controlled.

You could require a permit to send your technology or information overseas to another party, even if sent by email. There is a list of 'controlled items' including 'dual use' items that require a permit – the Defence and Strategic Goods List (DSGL).
