

Event	General Service Fee (Compulsory) calculation & Collection
Any student who has not paid their entire full year GSF and has an outstanding debt and their enrolment remains unchanged across the entire year.	GSF assessment will remain unchanged and must be paid as the debt was incurred prior to 1 July 2006. If the debt remains unpaid the student may have their enrolment 'terminated' on the August Unit Census Date and will not be allowed to re-enrol for 2007 or graduate.
A commencing (new) student enrolled in a unit with a teaching period that has a Unit Census Date prior to 1 July 2006.	GSF will be assessed and charged for the full year. Unit(s) with teaching period(s) that have a Unit Census Date in the second half year (if applicable) or Unit(s) with teaching period(s) that have a Unit Census Date in the first half year (if no second half year units) will be used to assess GSF.
A commencing (new) student enrolled in a unit(s) with teaching periods and Unit Census dates after 30 June 2006.	There will be no GSF assessment or collection.
Any student who has an enrolment that only includes an enrolment in unit(s) with teaching periods and a Unit Census date after (in the second half of the year only) 30 June 2006.	There will be no GSF assessment or collection.
Any student who has an enrolment in unit(s) with teaching periods and Unit Census dates in both halves of year.	GSF will be assessed and charged for the full year.
Any student who has an enrolment that only includes an enrolment in unit(s) with teaching periods and a Unit Census date prior (in the first half of the year only) 1 July 2006.	GSF will be assessed and charged for the first half of the year only.
Any student who changes their unit(s) enrolment and the GSF assessment on any date after 29 June 2006 has increased when compared to the GSF assessment as at 6 pm 29 June 2006.	GSF assessment will remain unchanged (not be reassessed or increased).
Any student changes their unit enrolment and the GSF assessment on any date after 29 June 2006 is unchanged when compared to assessment as at 6 pm 29 June 2006.	GSF assessment will remain unchanged.
Any student who changes their unit(s) enrolment and the GSF assessment on any date after 29 June 2006 decreases compared to assessment as at 6 pm 29 June 2006.	At the Student's request a GSF refund (credit) will be processed immediately after the Unit Census Date for discontinued unit(s) has passed.
