Special Consideration:

- A student who considers that his or her performance in an examination is adversely affected by illness or other cause immediately prior to or in the course of an examination may inform the supervisor at any time during the examination and shall subsequently furnish in writing to the Vice-Principal (Resources and Administration) a statement containing the circumstances together with any medical or such other evidence as may be applicable **not later than seventy-two hours after the commencement of the examination.**
- A student who considers that his or her studies during a year in respect of a unit or course have been adversely affected by illness or other cause shall furnish to the Vice-Principal (Resources and Administration) in writing a statement containing the circumstances, together with any medical or such other evidence as may be applicable **prior to any examination to which such application relates.**

Points on Examinations

- Students are required to make themselves **available for the entire duration of any official examination period.**
