

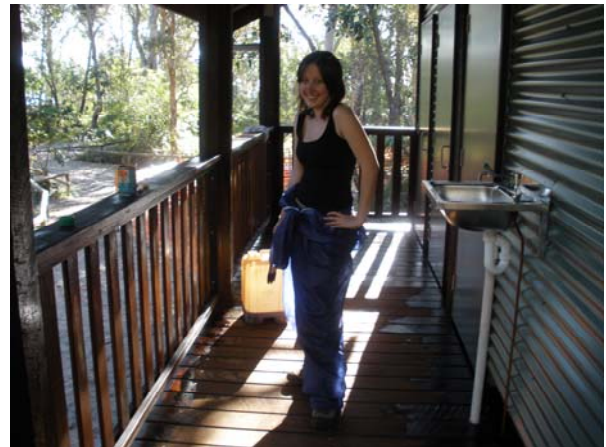
Industry placement profile
