

Information for Prize Winners Melbourne Campus Prize Ceremony

Pre-ceremony dinner: The pre-ceremony dinner is an opportunity for you to meet your prize donor and key Faculty staff. This is for prize winners only.

Ceremony: Prize winners may invite two guests to the ceremony. Tickets will not be issued, but please advise if you are bringing guests for catering purposes.

Spelling: Please check the spelling of your name on your invitation. Please advise us if your name is spelt incorrectly. Please also advise the pronunciation of your name if you think the presenter will have difficulty.

Special requirements: Please advise our office prior to Wednesday 6 July, if you require any special arrangements to be made in order to attend this ceremony, for example, an Auslan interpreter or wheelchair access.

Outline of event:

- The ceremony will be preceded by a dinner for prize-winners and donors at 6.30pm in the John Scott Meeting House Dining Room. Prize winners must arrive and register by this time (bring your ticket with you).
- Prize winners must be seated in their allocated seat by 7.50pm.
- Guests should arrive around 7.45pm and are to be seated by 7.55pm.
- The academic procession will enter the Chamber at 8.00pm.
- Ushers will manage the presentation. You will receive your prize from the Senior Deputy Vice-Chancellor and your prize donor may also attend.
- A professional photographer will take photos of the presentation. These will be available after the ceremony to purchase.
- Refreshments will be served after the ceremony, allowing donors and prize winners an opportunity to meet each other.

Inability to attend: In the event that you are unable to attend the ceremony, it is important that you advise our office so that we can inform the prize-donor. All uncollected certificates will be posted in the fortnight following the ceremony.

Parking: The ceremony will be held in the John Scott Meeting House at the Melbourne Campus. Parking is available in Car Park 7.
