A limited number of Commonwealth Supported Places are available for students applying to enrol in the following programs:

All applications will be considered on 'Academic Merit' for consideration of a Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP). Applications for a 1st Round CSP **must** be submitted by **end of October**.

Please note that CSP places are **NOT** available for mid year (Semester 2). Though, based on academic merit, students enrolled in the relevant courses for semester 2 may be considered for a CSP place in semester 1 the following year.

Applicants wishing to be considered for a Commonwealth Supported Place must include relevant documentation in order to be considered. Applicants who do not submit all relevant documentation may only be considered for a Full Fee Offer.

All applicants will be advised of the outcome of their application and relevant enrolment processes by mid – December.
