### **Terms of Reference**

- 1 To provide advice to the Deputy Vice-Chancellor (International & Future Students) on matters relating to international agreements and alliances, including external programs.
- 2 To make recommendations to the Board on University policies and guidelines particular to international students and external programs.

- 3 To monitor and report to the Board on compliance with University policy and quality assurance processes in their application to international students and external programs.
- 4 To monitor performance and report to the Board on compliance with ESOS regulations and any other statutory requirements, for all campuses where international students are enrolled.
- 5 To monitor performance and report to the Board upon:
  - (i) The recruitment and progress of international undergraduate and postgraduate coursework overseas students.
  - (ii) The recruitment and progress of international postgraduate research overseas students.
  - (iii) Study abroad and student exchange programs.
  - (iv) International student support programs.
  - (v) External programs.
- 6 To facilitate the exchange and dissemination across the University of information on international academic activities and issues.
