

GRADUATE CERTIFICATE IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Degree Requirements

For a pass in the Graduate Certificate, a student must complete a total of four subjects which comprises of three Core Subjects and one Elective Subject accumulating 60 credit points. The course is designed to be completed within one term of Full Time Study or one year of Part Time Study.

After successful completion of the Graduate Certificate, if a student achieves an average mark of 65% or above, they will be offered articulation into the Graduate Diploma in Business Administration and Exemptions will be given for subjects completed in the Graduate Certificate.
