

MASTER OF INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS

Degree Requirements

For a pass in the Master of International Business, you must complete a total of eight subjects which comprises of four Core Subjects and four Elective Subjects accumulating 120 credit points. The course is designed to be completed within one year of Full Time Study or two years of Part Time Study.

Course Structure - 2012

Students must complete all four Core Subjects and have a choice of the following Elective Subjects each of which has a 15 credit point value.
