School of Historical and European Studies

According to the results of the Quality Assurance surveys done at the end of Semester 1 and Semester 2 2006, students in the School of Historical and European Studies are satisfied with their subjects most or all of the time.

Each semester students are asked to comment on the quality of the subjects that they study in the School of Historical and European Studies. Students rank subjects on a scale of 1 to 5 with a score of 5 indicating that the student was very satisfied with the subject. The mean score for the 3432 student responses to the questionnaire in the School of Historical and European Studies subjects was 4.1.

This indicates that most students are very satisfied with the content and delivery of their subject.

Surveys are conducted in the last two weeks of each semester and each subject is surveyed at least every two years.
