2010 SPANISH STUDENT FILM FESTIVAL

University students are invited to produce or participate in the production of a short – no longer than 4 minutes - film, animation or cartoon in Spanish for the Spanish Student Film Festival 2010.

The theme of the film has to be linked to different aspects of Hispanic cultures.

Submitted entries should reflect the theme through creative stories about discovering new worlds and different cultures, an integrated topic linked to science or history in the Hispanic context, etc.

Spanish Student Film Festival submissions are due **Tuesday 2 March 2010**. Prizes to be won! Winners will screen at La Mirada Film Festival in April 2010 at ACMI.

1. Each prize will consist of a festival pass for the La Mirada Film Festival, a \$50 music voucher, and basket of goodies with a value of \$100 plus a certificate for the winning student.
2. Students should submit their entries (2 copies on DVD + 1 copy on DV cam or uncompressed Quicktime file) for each entry with attached entry form to:

3. Entries must arrive by post between 11 February and 2 March 2010. Entries after 2 March will not be considered.
4. The judging committee will be made up of sponsors and industry professionals. The winning entries will be informed of the outcome no later than 15 March 2010.
5. The winning films in each category will be shown at the 2010 La Mirada Film Festival.
6. Entries will not be returned and may be used for promotional purposes by the Spanish Education Office.
7. The Spanish Education Office cannot be held responsible for any missing or misplaced entries.
