

Planning YOUR Pathways

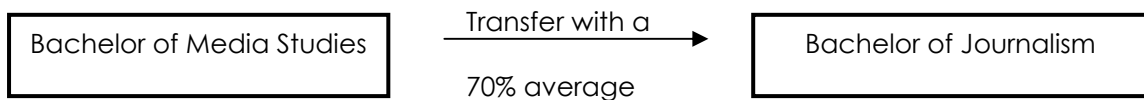
The following information is provided as a guide only.

Example One

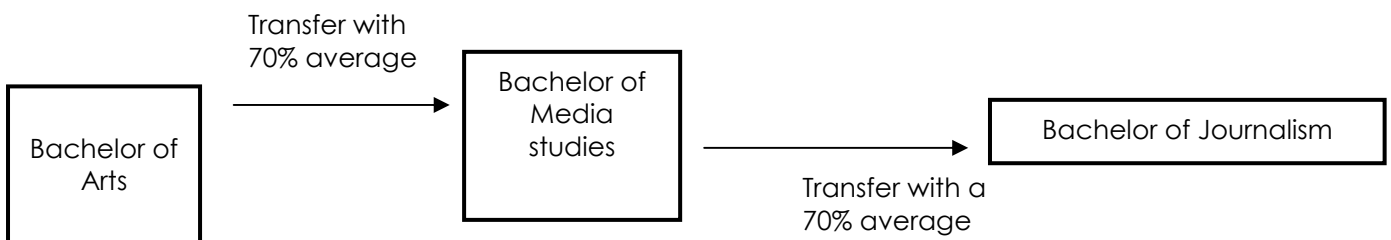
Julie really wants to study journalism. However, she did not meet the required enter for the Bachelor of Journalism degree.

At Change of Preference she found out that she could transfer from the Bachelor of Media studies into the Bachelor of Journalism (providing she obtained a B grade average) at the end of the year.

She also found out that the first year of the Bachelor of Media Studies is **exactly the same** as the first year of Bachelor of Journalism. So, she could go straight into second year of the Bachelor of Journalism degree if her transfer was successful!



She was also advised that if she did not make the ENTER for the Bachelor of Media Studies she could transfer from Arts into Media Studies and then into Bachelor of Journalism.



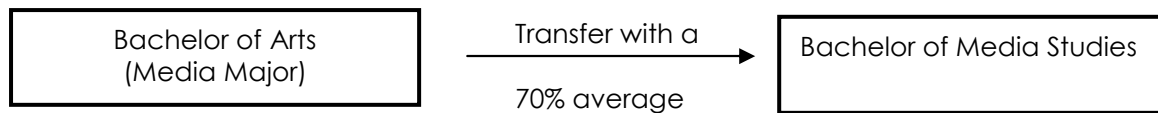
Her preference list looks like this:

Example Two

Mark did not get the required enter for Media Studies. His ENTER was 70.00
He had placed the Bachelor of Arts on his preference list and was advised that if he met the requirements he could transfer into the Bachelor of Media Studies at the end of the year.

At Change of Preference, he is also advised to do some of the media studies units to facilitate entry into the Bachelor of Media Studies.



His preference list looks like this:

1. First Preference: Bachelor of Media Studies (La Trobe)
2. Second Preference: Bachelor of Arts (La Trobe)

Example Three

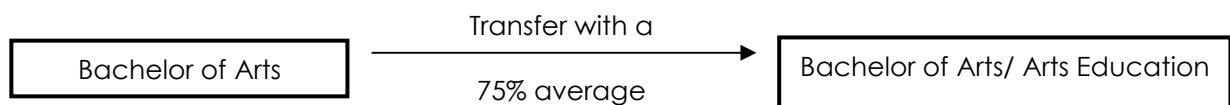
Cristina wants to be a secondary school teacher. She did not get the required ENTER for entry into the Bachelor of Arts/Arts Education.

She has been advised that she can plot her pathway by either:

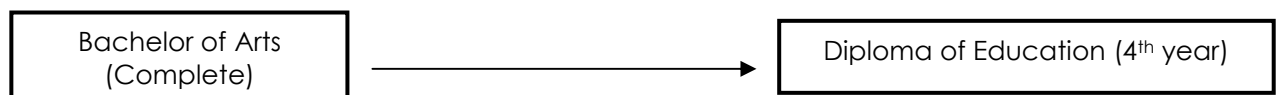
- A) Enrolling into the Bachelor of Arts and then transferring into the double degree at the end of the year (providing all requirements are met);
- B) Enrol and complete the Bachelor of Arts degree and then complete the Diploma of Education.

Both pathways take four years (of full-time study) to complete.

The **Bachelor of Arts/Arts Education** is also a four year degree if undertaken full-time.



OR

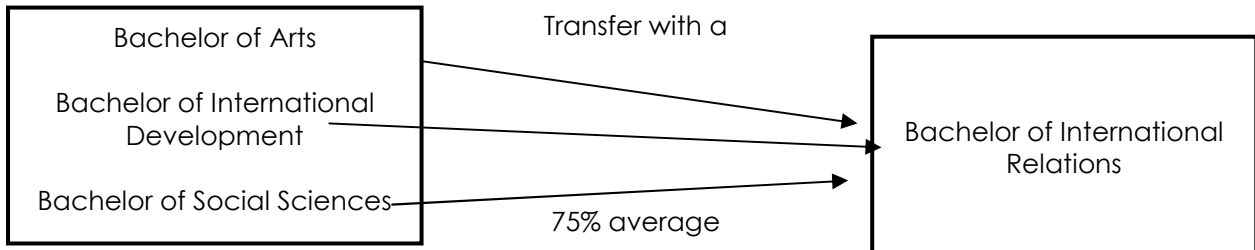


As an example, her preference list looks like this:

1. First Preference: Bachelor of Arts/ Bachelor of Arts Education (La Trobe)
2. Second Preference: Bachelor of Arts (La Trobe)
3. Third Preference: Bachelor of Social Sciences (La Trobe)

Example Four

Mohammed would like to work in international relations. He is interested in the Bachelor of International Relations degree, but does not think he will make the required ENTER. He has planned his preference list as flexible as possible, with a view of creating a pathway into the Bachelor of International Relations.

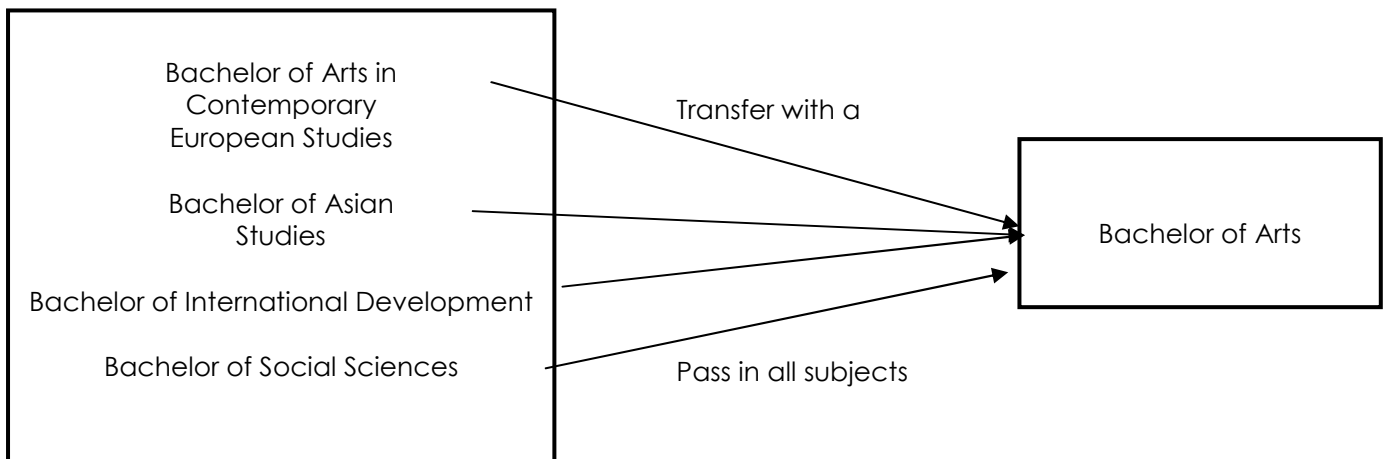


Here are his preferences:

Example Five

Peter would like to do Arts. Unfortunately, he did not meet the required ENTER. He has a number of options available to him.



Here are his preferences:

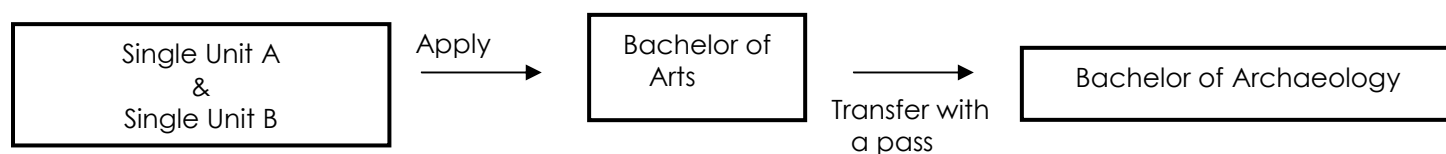

Example Six

Janelle did not make the required entry for ANY course. She is passionate about archaeology and would like to do the Bachelor of Archaeology.

At Change of Preference she was advised that she could:

- Enrol in two single units for first semester. If she passes both subjects she would be admitted into the Bachelor of Arts. Both units of study (if completed successfully) would be awarded credit to her degree. If she passes all units by the end of the year she could be admitted into the Bachelor of Archaeology.



Single Units are paid for up-front. You **DO NOT** apply through VTAC.
