High Achiever Scholarships

The Faculty of Science, Technology and Engineering offers a select number of high achiever scholarships to outstanding international students from Vietnam who wish to pursue any Bachelor degree program within the Faculty.

Value

There are two different scholarships available, one with full tuition fees paid for the duration of the course and the other is equivalent to 50% of the tuition fee for the duration of the course. Students must maintain a good academic record in every year level to retain the scholarship for the following year.

Eligibility

The scholarships are available to outstanding high school (Year 12) graduates from selected schools in Vietnam and University students currently studying in a 1st or 2nd year of an undergraduate degree program who have achieved the following English language proficiency:

- IELTS – a minimum overall band score of 6.0 with no individual band less than 6.0 or
- TOEFL – a minimum score of 550 with a score of 5 or better in the Test of Written English or
- TOEFL (computer-based) - a minimum score of 233 with a score of 5 in essay writing.

How to Apply

Prospective students must submit their application for admission to La Trobe University by 31 March, 2007 to commence their studies in July 2007 and by 30 November 2007 to commence their studies in February 2008.

Students must attach their year 12 results and a written **Statement of Purpose** to their application. Reference number **FSTE—VNS 07** must be quoted on the **Statement of Purpose**. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of **academic merit** and the written **Statement of Purpose**.
