CODE	MEANING	EXAMPLE
WW	Wrong Word	Criticisms have been made <b>WW</b> <u>on</u> the techniques used by earlier researchers.
WO	Word Order	There is evidence that this technique is <b>WO</b> <u>misunderstood badly</u> .
SS	Sentence Structure	These complexes can be considered ideal model systems, they require further research. <b>SS*</b> * a <i>comma splice error</i> - two sentences are separated by a comma, which is incorrect in English grammar. Although there have been several attempts at implementing this kind of algorithm. <b>SS*</b> * a <i>fragment</i> - not a complete sentence
SP	Spelling	Several <b>SP</b> <u>exports</u> have claimed that this is a superficial approach.
REF?	Requires a Reference	Many argue that psychology originated as its own discipline separate from philosophy around the late 1800s. <b>REF?</b>
ART	Missing Article (a/an/the)	This seems to be linked to <b>ART</b> ^ recently discovered gene.
WC	Wrong Word Class	It is argued that there should be a more <b>WC</b> <u>evenly</u> spread of sampling locations.
P	Punctuation	In the lab reports were made about misconduct <b>P*</b> * comma needed after 'lab'
VT	Verb Tense	In 1994, a new technique <b>VT</b> <u>is being developed</u> which...
VF	Verb Form	This <b>VF</b> <u>may be result</u> in a wide range of values.
^	Missing Word	There <b>^</b> two main methods of ionization.
S/PI	Singular/Plural Confusion	There are several risk <b>S/PI</b> <u>factor</u> that should be taken into account.
SV	Subject Verb Agreement	A high protein diet <b>SV</b> <u>give</u> a number of benefits.
