UNIVERSITY APPEALS COMMITTEE REGULATIONS 2009

The Council of La Trobe University makes these Regulations under sections 5 and 10 of the University Appeals Committee Statute 2009.

1. Name

These Regulations are the **University Appeals Committee Regulations 2009**.

2. Interpretation

In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears—
Committee means the University Appeals Committee.

3. Constitution of the Committee

- (1) The Vice-Chancellor may, by written notice, appoint any person who is a member of the academic staff or the general staff to be a member of the Committee on such reasonable terms and conditions as the Vice-Chancellor thinks fit and specifies in the written notice of appointment.
- (2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), the Vice-Chancellor may include terms and conditions relating to either or both of the following matters—
 - (a) the period for which the appointment is valid;
 - (b) the types of cases which the member may or may not sit as a member of the Committee on.

Example:

A notice of appointment may specify that the appointment is valid for 3 years and state that the appointee may sit on any sort of case other than cases arising under the **General Misconduct Statute 2009** or cases arising under the **Academic Misconduct Statute 2009** in respect of students undertaking postgraduate studies.

- (3) The Vice-Chancellor may revoke an appointment under subsection (1) at any time by giving written notice of the revocation to the appointee.
- (4) A revocation may be made at the request of the appointee or on the Vice-Chancellor's own motion.

- (5) A revocation takes effect at the time service of the notice is effected in accordance with section 5 of the **Interpretation Statute 2009** or at such later time as is specified in the notice.
