

**GENERAL :**

(a-2)

1. (1) There shall be a central library in the University which shall be under the control of the University Librarian with the advice of the Library Committee.

(a-2) (2) The Council may set up branch libraries in the Faculties or Colleges or any section or department thereof. Such branch libraries shall also be under the control of the University Librarian with the advice of the Library Committee.

**THE LIBRARY COMMITTEE :**

2. There shall be a Library Committee established by Council which shall advise  
(a-2) the University Librarian and staff on the development of library services in the  
(a-3) University and shall report on its meetings to the Academic Board to the Council.

3. The Council may make regulations concerning the composition of the Library Committee.

4. The Council may make regulations concerning the conduct of Library Committee meetings.

5. The Council may make regulations concerning the use of the libraries and each regulation may provide for penalties to be imposed for breach of any such regulations.

6. The Council may make regulations amending or revoking any such regulations.

7. The Council shall cause all regulations made under this statute to be promulgated by having them exhibited on an official notice board.

8. The Council shall cause any such regulations to be exhibited on the official notice board for at least fourteen days after being promulgated but days on which the University is on vacation shall not be counted in calculating the period of fourteen days.
