\$250

This prize is to be awarded annually to a student enrolled in at least one second year or third year mathematics unit, for a mathematical essay on a topic not covered in undergraduate units offered by the Department.

The prize is in honour of Dr Arthur Jones, who inspired staff and students by his dedication to student learning.

Professor C J Eliezer Prize in Second Year Mathematics

\$200

Awarded to the top second-year mathematics student enrolled in at least 45 credit points of second year mathematics units

Awarded to the most outstanding student in second year statistical science units.
