

Where to Eat?

At La Trobe

There are three lunch-time eating areas at La Trobe (and sadly nothing at night):

The Agora (coordinates G5 on La Trobe map), which has a wide selection of take-away food on both floors.

The Union (coordinates H7): here, you'll find downstairs the Eagle bar (which has a nice environment, is licensed and serves reasonable food), and on the middle level, Ping's Chinese (which is inexpensive).

Adams (in John Scott meeting house, coordinates J4): for table-cloth dining.
