

MIC11IEP is a 15 credit-point elective unit that was offered for the first time in 2005. Thirty three students enrolled in the subject of whom 22 completed the survey.

The survey suggested a high degree of student satisfaction with all aspects of the unit – that is, the majority of students indicated satisfaction “all or most of the time” to each of the specific survey questions.

Comments made by students in answer to “What was the best thing about the unit” included “the subject material covered by the lectures”, “the history of various diseases” the knowledge gained had “some real life applications rather than just factual information” and that “it was a very interesting and engaging subject – keep it going!”

A few students suggested that the 25% weighting for the written assignment be distributed over at least two shorter pieces of work and perhaps a mark allocated for the oral presentation during pracs. This seemed fair comment and will be addressed for the 2006.
