This document should be used in conjunction with the '2010 Re-enrolment Instructions' provided by the Division of Nursing and Midwifery.

The units listed on your enrolment page in StudentOnLine are predictive course structures. **The system will assume that you have completed all of the relevant units for the year level that you are completing and will not know if you have failed a unit or need to alter your enrolment plan.** In addition, the predictive structure will not include such things as electives. It is important that you use this document as a guide for your enrolment for 2010.

If you fail any 2nd or 3rd year units in 2009 or have altered your enrolment in any way, you should seek course structure advice from the Division of Nursing and Midwifery. Students may be required to transition into the new curriculum and should also refer to the transition instructions.

If there are units listed in your predictive course structure that you have already completed, do not attempt to enrol in them. They may be deleted or left as unconfirmed.

If there are units that you believe you should be doing in 2010, you should check with the relevant Coordinator (see page 3 of 2009 re-enrolment instructions for contacts) prior to entering them on your enrolment page.

If you will have completed some (but not all) of the prior years units by the end of this year, you should contact your Coordinator prior to completing your re-enrolment.

Students with clinical are reminded that valid **Police Checks (dated in the year of clinical)** and **Working with Children Checks** are required for clinical placement.
