Single Subject & Continuing Education



Single Subject enrolment provides students with the opportunity to apply for admission to a miscellaneous enrolment, where only one or two subjects are undertaken. Such subjects are undertaken for interest and at a later stage, may be credited toward a degree.

A miscellaneous subject is one taken in a non-award course, e.g. an enabling course, preparatory course, or taken as a standard alone subject by a student who is not enrolled in any formal course of study.

Continuing education refers to any type of post-secondary education, used to either obtain additional certifications, or as credits required to maintain a license. It can take the form of workshops, seminars, home-study or online courses, conferences, or hands-on training. There is no specific format or length for a continuing education program: some may take a weekend, while others can span weeks or even months.

Single Subject Studies

Every year, the Division offers some individual subjects for enrolment on a fee for service basis.

Students enrolling in single subjects have full access to facilities. Under certain conditions, successfully completed assessed subjects may be considered for credit towards a postgraduate degree.

The Division currently offers Continuing Education in Nurse Immuniser Program and Wound Management short courses.

The Immuniser Program is available to both Division 1 Registered Nurses who wish to become Accredited Nurse Immunisers and those who seek reaccreditation.

The Wound Management Program aims to improve wound care management achieved by combining knowledge, skills and application, in a flexible learning environment, tailored to the student needs.

Duration

The single subject study is normally conducted over a full semester and may be offered twice a year.

The Nurse Immuniser program is offered three times a year.

The Wound Management course is offered from February to November every year in six different locations.
