Aged Care Nursing Scholarships available

Royal College of Nursing, Australia (RCNA) is pleased to announce that undergraduate and postgraduate applications are now open. The scholarships are funded by the Australian Government and administered by RCNA. They provide financial assistance for undergraduate nursing study and postgraduate educational nursing study programs or courses, including relevant accredited tertiary level or TAFE level courses, workshops and conference participation in Australia.

► Aged Care Nursing Scholarship Scheme: Undergraduate

Undergraduate scholarships are available to people who can demonstrate a commitment to aged care and wish to undertake undergraduate education at an Australian university in 2010. The scholarships are only available for courses leading to a qualification to practice as a Registered/Division 1 Nurse.

- The Scholarship is valued up to \$30,000 to assist in meeting costs incurred while studying undergraduate nursing.

Undergraduate applications close Friday 25 August 2009.

► Aged Care Nursing Scholarship Scheme: Postgraduate-Continuing Education

This program is open for applications for financial assistance in the form of a scholarship valued at:

- up to \$15,000 for Registered/Division 1 Nurses studying for their Masters
- up to \$10,000 to assist both Registered/Division 1 Nurses and Enrolled Nurses working in aged care facilities to undertake further education in 2010.

Postgraduate applications close Friday 25 September 2009.
