 3. International students are reminded that the University is obliged to inform Immigration once you withdraw/discontinue. Your visa will normally remain valid for only 28 days from this date. If you wish to remain in Australia beyond 28 days, you will need to apply for a new visa from the Department of Immigration & Multicultural & Indigenous Affairs.
