Policy Statement	No research receiving funding support from the tobacco industry, either from its Institution or from individual companies, shall be permitted.
Supporting Procedures	The Research and Graduate Studies Office will not process any proposals or applications for funding from the tobacco industry. No funding support from the tobacco industry will be accepted.
