NOTES FOR RE-ENROLLING STUDENTS
2010

The following notes are to assist you in your re-enrolment. Please read them in conjunction with the re-enrolment advice at http://www.latrobe.edu.au/acadserv/current/enrol_reenrol.html.

Course structure

The degree requires at least 360 credit points, consisting of 120 credit points accrued from units taken at each of the first, second and third-year levels.

An additional requirement is that students must take psychology units at second and third-year level of not less than 120 credit points and to graduate, students must successfully complete a minimum of 150 credit points of psychology units across the three years of the degree.

NOTE TO ALL STUDENTS

- the total number of credit points may be greater than 120 in any year, but must not exceed 140 credit points, without permission from the course adviser
- enrolments exceeding 120 credit points in any year will accrue proportionately higher HECS liabilities for that year

- student number quotas and timetabling clashes might affect final choices.
