La Trobe University is one of the leading research universities in Australia.

The University has internationally regarded strengths across a diverse range of disciplines.

The University is proud to be in the forefront of research in Australia and internationally. Students pursuing postgraduate study at La Trobe will be studying with the support of staff and facilities which are world class.

La Trobe University offers a detailed and broad research training program and provides unique access to technology transfer and collaboration with end users of our research and training via its Research and Development Park.

Scholarship Opportunities

As part of La Trobe University's commitment to excellence, it offers an extensive scholarship program for postgraduate students who are undertaking higher degrees by research. Scholarships are awarded on the basis of excellence to persons of exceptional promise.

Scholarships are available for Australian and New Zealand citizens, permanent residents and international students.

In 2009 La Trobe University will award over 100 living allowance scholarships to candidates enrolling in Doctoral and Masters by research programs, and over 40 fees awards to meet tuition costs for international students.

There are five scholarship schemes currently available at La Trobe University:

- Australian Postgraduate Award
- La Trobe University Postgraduate Research Scholarship

- David Myers Research Scholarship
- Endeavour International Postgraduate Research Scholarship
- La Trobe Fee Remission Research Scholarship

Living allowance scholarships are awarded initially for a period of up to three years for Doctoral candidates and up to two years for Masters by research candidates.

Application Procedures

La Trobe University's postgraduate research program includes Doctoral and Masters degrees by research.

Applicants for Doctoral candidature should have completed an Honours Bachelor degree at a very high level of achievement or already hold a Masters degree.

Applicants for Masters by research candidature are usually required to have completed an Honours degree or Masters Preliminary.

Prospective local applicants for Doctoral and Masters by research degrees should contact the Faculty in which they wish to study to ascertain the availability of supervision and to obtain an application kit.

International students should contact the International Programs Office or visit the University's International web site for information about application procedures and study opportunities at La Trobe University. See: latrobe.edu.au/international/courses/research.html

The closing date for applications for candidature and scholarships is 31 October 2008 for Australian and New Zealand citizens and 30 September 2008 for overseas applicants.
