

David Myers Research Scholarship

Dr David M. Myers, the University's Foundation Vice-Chancellor, passed away in November 1999. In memory of Dr Myer's contribution to the University, and as part of the University's commitment to the conduct of high quality research and research training, each year the University will offer the highest University-ranked applicant for a postgraduate research scholarship the **David Myers Research Scholarship**. The scholarship will be open to outstanding individuals, regardless of discipline or nationality. The scholarship will include:

- A stipend of \$23,000 per annum for three years full-time study for a PhD or 2 years full-time study for a Masters degree;
- A research support grant of up to \$3,000 per annum to assist with costs such as laboratory consumables, fieldwork and attendance at conferences;
- Relocation and removal expenses to a campus of the University;
- Exemption from liability under the Higher Education Contribution Scheme while the holder of the award; and
- A thesis allowance of up to \$910.
