1. HOW DO I APPLY?

2. WHEN SHOULD I APPLY?

NOW! (open until late December). If Bendigo is a preference for you, then apply. Application is FREE, so you have nothing to lose.

3. HOW MUCH IS ACCOMMODATION?

Prices vary depending on facilities and catering options. Our web-site has the full price options - discounted rates for up-front payment.

4. WHEN DO I MOVE IN?

Mid-February. Your first few days consist of Resfest (Ressies' Orientation Program) which leads into the Uni Orientation Week. Resfest is a chance to settle in quickly and make some great friends.

5. HOW LONG DO I STAY FOR?

Standard Licence Agreements are for the full Academic Year – 40 weeks. Short-term stays attract higher rates.

6. WHO ARE MY ROOM-MATES, AND AM I ALLOWED VISITORS?

You will have your own bedroom and share lounge, kitchen, bathroom and laundry facilities. Visitors are welcomed on an occasional basis.

7. WHAT ABOUT PARKING MY CAR OR MY BIKE?

For a fee, a Uni parking permit will entitle you to park at your residence. Covered bike racks are provided.

8. WHAT AM I GOING TO EAT?

At the Halls the food by *Food for Thought* is fantastic and you can save time shopping, cooking and cleaning ... or at the Terraces, Units and Orde House you can cook on your own or team up with some friends.

9. WHAT TECHNOLOGY IS AVAILABLE?

Wireless Internet, printing services and computer labs are available for all residents.

10. WHAT'S ON RES AND WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

Rooms contain a bed, study desk, lamp, study chair, wardrobe and pinboard. Common areas have TVs, fridges, ironing facilities, basic kitchen appliances and cooking utensils and some cutlery and crockery. The personal touch is up to you.
