

## LESLIE KILMARTIN REGIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

---

### SECTION 1 GENERAL INFORMATION

The Leslie Kilmartin Regional Scholarship was established by Professor Leslie Kilmartin upon his retirement as Pro Vice-Chancellor and Dean of La Trobe University, Bendigo in September 2003. Professor Kilmartin indicated a preference for support to students from regional Victoria, who may have not previously had the opportunity to enter university and who are undertaking their first university degree at the Bendigo Campus of La Trobe University.

<b>Conditions of Eligibility</b>	The scholarship shall be made to a full-time undergraduate student who is commencing higher education for the first time, after a period away from full-time study.
<b>Selection Criteria</b>	<p>Applicants must be attempting their first university qualification.</p> <p>Applicants should not have been in full-time education in the past three years.</p> <p>Applicants must clearly demonstrate how the scholarship will be used to support their study, if successful.</p> <p>Applicants should provide details of family circumstance and family financial position.</p> <p>Preference for the scholarship will be given to applicants from the central and northern Victoria region.</p> <p>Selection of the successful candidates will be on the recommendation of a Selection Committee consisting of:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Executive Director, Bendigo campus, (or nominee)</li><li>• Manager, Student Administration, Bendigo (or nominee)</li><li>• Nominee of the Bendigo Tertiary Education Anniversary Foundation Advisory Board.</li></ul>
<b>Number of Awards</b>	One award will be made annually. The Board reserves the right to vary, or not to make the award in a specific year; if there are insufficient applicants, or if applicants are deemed by the selection panel not to have demonstrated eligibility based on the selection criteria.
<b>Value of the Award</b>	To be determined annually by the Board of the Bendigo Tertiary Education Anniversary Foundation, valued at \$500 in 2010.
<b>Presentation</b>	The scholarship will be formally presented at the La Trobe University Bendigo Awards Ceremony and an appropriate notation made on the student's academic record.
<b>Applications</b>	Applications must be lodged on the Application Form, to Student Administration at the Bendigo Campus by 31 March. Applications must include evidence of acceptance or enrolment into an undergraduate degree.

All applications will be acknowledged.
