BENDIGO UNITED FRIENDLY SOCIETIES PHARMACY SCHOLARSHIP

The Bendigo United Friendly Societies Pharmacy Scholarship has been established by the Bendigo United Friendly Societies Pharmacies Limited to support a student from regional Victoria undertaking the Bachelor of Pharmacy course at the Bendigo Campus of La Trobe University.

Title	The scholarship shall be called "Bendigo United Friendly Societies Pharmacy Scholarship"
Conditions of Eligibility	The scholarship shall be made to a full-time Bachelor of Pharmacy student from regional Victoria who have successfully completed the first year of study at LaTrobe University Bendigo.
Selection Criteria	<p>Applicants must be attempting their first tertiary education qualification.</p> <p>Applicants should not be in receipt of any other scholarship.</p> <p>Preference will be given to applicants from the City of Greater Bendigo region.</p> <p>Selection of the successful candidate will be on the recommendation of a Selection Committee consisting of :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Registrar (or nominee)Course CoordinatorNominated representatives of Bendigo United Friendly Societies Pharmacies Limited <p>Applicants may be required to attend an interview with the Selection Committee.</p>
Number of Awards	One award will be made available annually.
Value of the Award	<p>\$6,500 per year tenable for three years of the course - Payable upon confirmation of enrolment in semester one of the second, third and fourth year of the course.</p> <p>Confirmation of Enrolment is normally held in mid-March and mid-August.</p> <p>Continuation of the scholarship will be subject to review and satisfactory academic performance in each year of the course.</p>
Professional	<p>The successful candidate will be expected to undertake a portion of their Pharmacy Board of Victoria student hours at Bendigo United Friendly Societies Pharmacies Limited. Part time employment may be available throughout the course.</p> <p>Upon registration the scholarship holder will agree to work for Bendigo United Friendly Societies Pharmacies Limited for a period not less than two years or repay the money paid to them under the scholarship. Pre-registration employment will be available with Bendigo United Friendly Societies Pharmacies Ltd, however pre-registrants are encouraged to broaden their experience and therefore may seek pre-registration with another employer.</p>
Presentation	The scholarship will be formally presented at the Annual La Trobe University, Bendigo Awards Ceremony and an appropriate notation made on the student's academic record.
Applications	Applications addressing the selection criteria on the Application Form must be received by the Course Administrative Officer, School of Pharmacy & Applied Science by 30 September each year. Successful applicants will be notified as soon as possible and not later than the semester one HESA census date.
