This form should be used by applicants eligible to apply for a place at La Trobe University Albury-Wodonga and Mildura campuses under Alternative Category Entry applying through UAC (Universities Admissions Centre NSW & ACT).

Alternative Category Entry

Applicants in the following categories may apply to La Trobe University under Alternative Category Entry. Applicants should note requirements vary from course to course.

1) Mature Age and Education

Applicants who are aged 21 years or over by 1 January 2010 and **have not** completed a semester of tertiary level studies (including post-year 12 TAFE qualifications, Cert 4 and above) in the last two years. Mature-age entry is for applicants who have accumulated relevant experience since leaving school. This category is for an applicant who can demonstrate relevant work and/or life experience and indicate how this is likely to assist them successfully complete the course(s) for which they have applied.

How to apply

- Make an application through UAC as a non-year 12 applicant.
- Undertake a STAT Multiple Choice Test (except Visual Arts, Graphic Design or Education).
- Fulfil any extra requirements specified in the course entries in the 2010 UAC Guide.
- Deadline for all requirements is 8 January 2010 or by the closing date for each subsequent offer round. Late applicants should contact the Admissions Officer on (02) 60 249790.
- Applicants in the Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Psychological Science, Bachelor of Human Services and Master of Social Work must provide an autobiographical essay.
- Applicants may be required to, or given the opportunity to attend an interview.

2) Indigenous applicants

Aborigine and Torres Straits Islanders are encouraged to apply for entry into this University and will be considered on an individual basis. Current HSC/VCE or equivalent students can apply through UAC or VTAC. Other applicants may apply direct. The Autobiographical Essay

The essay should be approximately, but not more than, 1000 words long and must cover the following points:

- your reasons for wishing to undertake the undergraduate course(s) of study for which you are applying;
- the subject areas that interest you and why;
- your reasons for believing that you can successfully complete an undergraduate course of study.

Additional Information

Applicants whose principal language of educational instruction was other than English, must provide evidence of their proficiency in English. This can be done by achieving a satisfactory result in Year 12 English or in an IELTS or another test acceptable to the University.
