

# Outdoor and Environmental Education

## Electives 2012

The following course structures have electives:

- Natural Resources Education (5)
- Nature Tourism (5)
- Outdoor Education (3)
- Outdoor Environmental Education (3)

Any subject of university study may be taken for an elective as long as

- it is worth at least 15cp (credit points) and
- no more than 150cp of the course is taken at first year level.

Students must check at the beginning of semester or sooner to ensure that there are no timetable clashes. In some instances it may be necessary to choose an alternative elective.

Subjects may be chosen for electives to make up the discipline requirements for a Victorian Institute of Teaching (VIT) recognised method of study. For further information see the VIT Specialist Area Guidelines under Teacher Education at <http://www.vit.vic.edu.au>.

Definitions:

*Part*: Successful tertiary study in a subject having the weighting of at least one quarter of a year of full-time study in the course from which it is derived.

*Sub-major*: A total of half a year of successful full-time tertiary study, usually comprising sequential discipline study taken over two years, e.g. a part in each of the first and second years of tertiary study, or equivalent study." *VIT Specialist Area Guidelines*
