Using student engagement data to change practice

Hosted by La Trobe University and the Australian Council for Educational Research, the 2010 Student Engagement Forum focuses on how student engagement data can be used for improving students' learning. It looks broadly at how evidence from surveys can be used to enhance practice and quality improvement.

The forum includes keynote presentations by Associate Professor Alexander McCormick (NSSE Director; Indiana University), workshops and facilitated discussions, and an overview of headline AUSSE results by Associate Professor Hamish Coates (AUSSE Director; Australian Council for Educational Research).

This Student Engagement Forum is intended for practitioners working in areas of teaching and learning, student affairs and engagement, institutional research and quality assurance, learning support, first year orientation and induction and academic development.
