MATURE AGE ENTRY FORM 2007 - EXTRA REQUIREMENTS
Bachelor of Arts - Humanities and Social Sciences

Eligibility

You are eligible to apply through the (SEAS) Mature Age Entry Scheme if you are aged 21 years or more on 1 January 2008 and you have either:

- not satisfactorily completed VCE or equivalent **or**
- satisfactorily completed VCE or equivalent but have not completed a semester of tertiary study more than two years ago.

If you have satisfactorily completed VCE or equivalent and/or have completed one or more semesters of tertiary study within the past two years, you are not eligible to apply through the (SEAS) Mature Age Entry Scheme and should apply as a regular Victorian Tertiary Admissions Centre (VTAC) applicant.

How to apply

All applicants must:

1. Submit a course application to VTAC not later than 28 September 2007 to VTAC.
2. Submit a VTAC Special Entry Access Scheme (SEAS) form to VTAC by the 12TH October 2007.
3. Register through VTAC for the Special Tertiary Admission Test (STAT-Multiple Choice) by 28 September, 2007.
4. Submit a La Trobe (SEAS) Mature Age Entry Scheme Form together with your autobiographical essay, to the Faculty Selection Officer not later than 12th October 2007 for consideration in the VTAC early round offer. VTAC Round 1, 2 or 3 offer applications can still be accepted beyond this date.

Applicants who have missed registering with VTAC for the STAT by the 28th September, may still register for the second STAT to be held on Saturday 1 December 2007 (closing date for registration for the second STAT is 16 November 2007). A late fee applies for these applications.

The Autobiographical Essay

The essay should not be more than 1,000 words and must cover the following points:

- your reasons for wishing to undertake the undergraduate course of study for which you are applying;
- the subject areas that interest you and why;
- your reasons for believing that you can successfully complete an undergraduate course of study.

Additional Information

You are eligible if you are:-

- an Australian or New Zealand citizen,
- an Australian permanent resident,
- hold an Australian permanent humanitarian visa.

Applicants from a non-English speaking background may be required to provide evidence of an International English Language Testing System score (IELTS). For the 2007 test dates contact:
