UNIVERSITY APPEALS COMMITTEE REGULATIONS 2014

The Council of La Trobe University makes these Regulations under the University Appeals Committee Statute 2009.

1. Name

These Regulations are the **University Appeals Committee Regulations 2014**.

2. Interpretation

In these Regulations, *Committee* means the University Appeals Committee.

3. Appointment of Committee members

- (1) The Vice-Chancellor may appoint any person to be a member of the Committee if the Vice-Chancellor believes, on reasonable grounds, that the person has suitable skills and experience. An appointment under this subsection—
 - (a) must be made by written notice; and
 - (b) may be made subject to such reasonable terms and conditions as the Vice-Chancellor thinks fit and specifies in the written notice.
- (2) Without limiting the generality of subsection (1), the Vice-Chancellor may include terms and conditions relating to either or both of the following matters—
 - (a) the period for which the appointment is valid;
 - (b) the types of appeals on which the member may or may not sit.
- (3) The Vice-Chancellor may vary or revoke an appointment under subsection (1) at any time by giving written notice of the variation or revocation to the appointee. Without limiting the generality of this subsection, a variation may impose, vary or remove terms and conditions to which the appointment is, or is to be, subject.
- (4) A variation or revocation under subsection (3)—
 - (a) may be made at the request of the appointee or on the Vice-

Chancellor's own motion; and

- (b) takes effect at the time that service of the written notice of variation or revocation is done in accordance with section 5 of the **Interpretation Statute 2009** or at such later time as is specified in the notice.

4. Revocation and transitional

- (1) The **University Appeals Committee Regulations 2009** are revoked.
- (2) An appointment of a member of the Committee which was in effect under the **University Appeals Committee Regulations 2009** immediately prior to the commencement of these Regulations continues in effect as if made under these Regulations on or after that commencement.
- (3) Nothing in subsection (2) is intended to constitute a contrary intention for the purposes of section 41 (or any other provision) of the *Interpretation of Legislation Act 1986*.
