What is problem behaviour?

There are a range of behaviours that might be unacceptable, concerning, unwelcome or make you feel uncomfortable, including:

- Bullying
- Harassment
- Discrimination
- Sexual harm
- Family violence
- Aggression
- Stalking
- Threats
- Violence

When can I contact Safer Community?

Whenever you have safety or wellbeing concern for yourself or someone else, and you want confidential and free advice about what to do. You can still contact us if your concerns happened off campus, if it happened a long time ago but continues to impact on you, or if you

want to remain anonymous (use our online reporting form).

What happens when I contact Safer Community?

If you provided your name and contact details, we will contact you to talk about your support and safety options at the University and externally.

We will provide assistance and ongoing support to connect with any other services at the University or externally that can assist you. Any information you provide will be kept confidential and will not be disclosed without your request or permission.
