Eligibility and Nomination Criteria for Students

Eligibility

A student is defined by the La Trobe University Act to be

- a. a person enrolled at the University in a course leading to a degree or other award; or
- b. a person who is designated as a student or is of a class of persons designated as students by the Council

Under the Academic Board Regulations, the prescribed student membership of Academic Board is

- one enrolled graduate research candidate, elected by and from the graduate research candidates of the University.
- two enrolled postgraduate students, elected by and from the postgraduate students of the University. One must be from a metropolitan campus and one must be from a regional campus
- three enrolled undergraduate students, to be elected by and from the undergraduate students of the University. One must be from a metropolitan campus and one must be from a regional campus

Membership will cease if a student member ceases to be an enrolled student at any time during the one year term.

You must meet the criteria above to be eligible to nominate for membership of Academic Board.

Nominating

Your nomination must be submitted via the <u>online form</u> available from 27 September 2023.

Your nomination must be accompanied by

- A photograph
- A supporting statement of no more than 400 words
- Evidence that two enrolled students (nominators) from the same category of students support your nomination. For example, if you are an undergraduate student your nominators must be enrolled undergraduate students. Evidence should be a saved email from each nominator's La Trobe University email address.

Nominations which do not meet the above criteria at the closing time for nominations **will not be** accepted.

In the case of an election being required, your uploaded photograph and supporting statement will be published on the election website.
