Psychology Field Placement

PSY3PFP is a 30 credit-point psychology elective subject typically taken between the 2nd and 3rd year of a full-time Bachelor of Psychological Science or Bachelor of Psychology (Honours) degree, or in later years for part-time students or students in accredited psychology double degrees.

As part of a partnership with the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS), students complete a 150 to 200 hour placement on site with DHHS. Placements are offered throughout the state including near our La Trobe campuses. While most placements are with Child Protection Services, each year a range of placement types is offered, including Corporate placements. Past students have worked in areas such as OHS, People and Culture, Legal Office, Housing, Disability Services, and even Cybersecurity. Students develop skills for professional workplaces and enhance their employability skills.
