La Trobe's <u>Bachelor of Biomedical Science (Medical) program</u> is exclusively offered to 15 students across our Bendigo and Albury Wodonga campuses. This is a highly competitive course. You will have to have lived regionally (MMM2 - 7) for 5 years consecutively or 10 years cumulatively. Another component of the admission process is the submission of your rurality form.

To be considered for an interview for admission into the Bachelor of Biomedical Science (Medical) degree, applicants who are current Year 12 high school students will receive a La Trobe Entrance Rank (LTER) based on selection indicators as determined by completion of this form. The LTER and the rurality form will be used to determine which current Year 12 applicants are offered an interview.

As part of the application process, students are required to have this form completed by a designated staff member at their school – either the VCE or Year 11 Coordinator (or nominee). By signing this form, the designated staff member is declaring that the information provided is complete and accurate.

Please ensure that a copy of your official Year 11 results are submitted with this form.
