

2023 'Picturing Respect' – Photography Competition Terms and Conditions

Competition

1. La Trobe University (ABN 64 804 735 113) ("**La Trobe**") is conducting a competition called the "**Picturing Respect Photography Competition**" ("**Competition**").
2. These terms and conditions apply to the Competition and by submitting your entry you agree to be bound by these terms and conditions. Any entry that does not comply with these terms and conditions may be deemed invalid and ineligible to win a prize.
3. The Competition is open from 12:00am AEST Monday 23 October 2023 to 11:59:59pm AEST Sunday 12 November 2023 ("**Competition Period**"). Any entry received after the expiry of the Competition Period will be deemed invalid. No responsibility is accepted for late, lost, delayed or misdirected entries. La Trobe reserves the right to extend the Competition Period in its sole discretion.

Entry

4. The Competition is open to all currently enrolled La Trobe University students and currently employed La Trobe University staff members (Health, Wellbeing and Inclusion staff members are excluded from entering and participating in this Competition).
5. Entrants less than 18 years old must obtain the consent of a parent or guardian to enter. La Trobe may request photographic ID as proof of an entrant's age and request written evidence of parental or guardian consent (if applicable). Any entrant that is unable or unwilling to provide the requested information will not be eligible to win a prize.
6. Entrants must:
 - a. submit a photograph that reflects the theme "Respect is....." in the context of the *Respect Women: 'Call it Out' (Respect Is)* campaign promoted by Respect Victoria. Information about the campaign can be found via <<https://www.respectvictoria.vic.gov.au/campaigns/respect-women-call-it-out-respect>> Entrants must submit their photograph via the link <[Microsoft form](#)>. Entrants must be logged into their La Trobe University account to access the form and complete the entry details.
 - b. entrants must submit a photograph taken by themselves.
7. Entry into the Competition is free.
8. Entrants may enter the Competition once - one entry per entrant is permitted.
9. Any entries deemed by La Trobe to be inappropriate or offensive will be ineligible to win a prize and excluded from the Competition.
10. By submitting an entry, each entrant warrants to La Trobe that:
 - (a) if below 18 years of age, they have the permission of their parent or guardian to enter the Competition;
 - (b) all details provided with their entry are true and accurate;
 - (b) the entrant owns or has the right to submit their entry for this Competition;
 - (c) the entrant has obtained consent from any person in their entry to use their image for this Competition;
 - (d) their entry, and La Trobe's use of their entry, will not:
 - infringe any person's copyright or other intellectual property rights;

- infringe any person's privacy rights or any applicable privacy laws; or
 - breach any other laws.
11. Each entrant grants to La Trobe a perpetual, royalty-free licence to use, reproduce, publish and communicate their entry, including a right to sublicense it to other parties (including posting on La Trobe's social media accounts, in any format for the purpose of the Competition and for La Trobe's marketing and promotional purposes.

Judging and Prizes

La Trobe will judge all valid entries received within the Competition Period and select winners in a separate staff and student category based on:

- a) creativity and originality of concept.
 - b) aesthetic merit of photograph; and
 - c) clarity of and connection to the overall theme and which photo best represents the theme as outlined in point 6a above.
12. ("**Prize Winners**"). This Competition is not a game of chance and chance plays no part in determining the Prize Winners.
13. La Trobe will select up to 3 people to win a prize.
14. The prizes will consist of:
- a. first prize in both staff and student category: Coles Myer voucher to value of \$250.
 - b. second prize first prize in both staff and student category: Coles Myer voucher to value of \$100.
 - c. third prize first prize in both staff and student category: Coles Myer voucher to value of \$50.
15. The prizes cannot be redeemed for cash.
16. The Prize Winners will be notified within 8 days after the end of the Competition Period by email. Prize Winners will also be published on La Trobe's website and social media accounts.
17. The decisions of La Trobe regarding Prize Winners are final and will be binding on each entrant. No correspondence or communications will be entered into. If after reasonable efforts a Prize Winner cannot be contacted, cannot accept a prize or is deemed to be ineligible to enter the Competition, La Trobe reserves the right to select a different Prize Winner.
18. If any event prevents or hinders the Competition or La Trobe's ability to deliver a prize, La Trobe may in its absolute discretion cancel the Competition, select another Prize Winner, or provide a similar prize of equivalent value.
19. La Trobe may refuse to award a prize, or seek its recovery, in the event of the relevant entrant's fraud, dishonesty, or non-entitlement under, or breach of, these terms and conditions. In the event of a dispute concerning the identity of the person who submits an entry, the entry will be deemed to have been submitted by the owner of the email account on which the entry is posted.
20. Each entrant acknowledges and agrees that the Coles Myer vouchers may be subject to third party additional terms and conditions which La Trobe has no control or influence over. The Prize Winners accept the Coles Myer vouchers in the condition they are presented in.

Personal information

21. Each entrant consents to La Trobe using any personal information supplied or connected with their entry for the purposes of the Competition and for La Trobe's marketing and promotional purposes.

To the extent such warranties cannot be excluded by law but liability can lawfully be limited, liability is limited at La Trobe's option to replacing the prize or the cost of replacing the prize or acquiring an equivalent item.
