Admission Requirements	Students should have the requisite GPA as defined in the MOU. In
	addition students whose first language isn't English or who aren't
	studying at a university where English is the language of instructions
	should be proficient enough with spoken and written English to feel
	comfortable in academic and social settings; the majority of classes are
	taught in English. A normal TOEFL range is 70-75 and 5.5 IELTS. Students
	who have not taken the TOEFL or IELTS can undergo a language
	evaluation by their home university and submit this as proof of language
	ability. If you have students who scored below a 70 or 5.5 please contact
	our office in advance of nomination.
Accommodation	All exchange students are placed in on-campus housing. The housing
	application is released to students after their acceptance.
