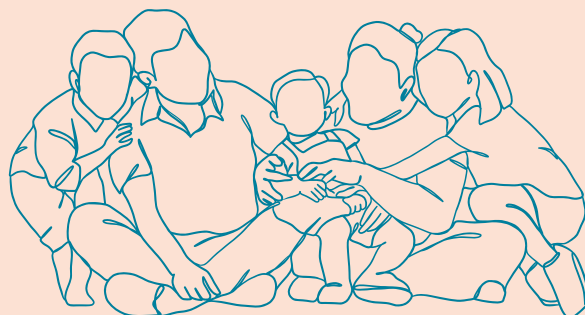


FAMILY WORK CHAMPIONS PROGRAM
