As a University, we focus on making immediate, real-world impact. Not the long term, unachievable plans that never come to life – we believe in empowering people to create real impact in their worlds.

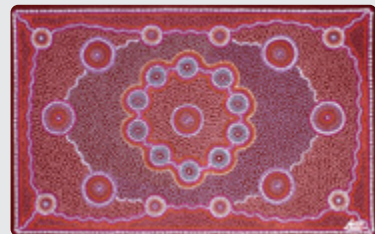

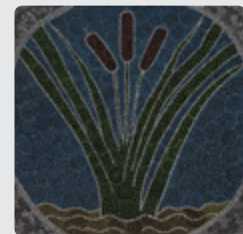

Melbourne (Bundoora)

ACCOMMODATION GUARANTEE

Take the stress out of moving away from home and starting uni with a guaranteed accommodation place at La Trobe for first-year students.

Eligibility

- You must be a student who is relocating from outside of metropolitan Melbourne to study at our Melbourne (Bundoora) or City Campus.

Requirements

- You must have accepted your offer to study in 2024, or are re-enrolling to study in Semester 1, 2024.
- The guarantee does not continue beyond the initial lease term for non-Indigenous students.
- If Living at La Trobe's sites are full, the accommodation guarantee extends to other UniLodge properties in metropolitan Melbourne.
- The guarantee does not cover any accommodation costs and fees.

INDIGENOUS ACCOMMODATION SCHOLARSHIP

We know how important safe, secure and affordable housing is for our students. That's why we're offering Indigenous students a place in our student accommodation across all our campuses.

For students on ABSTUDY with Rent Assistance, we have accommodation options with no gap. This means you can live on campus at no financial cost to you.

Accommodation offers are limited by available stock.¹

Eligibility

- Identify, be accepted as, or be of Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander descent.
- Apply for admission and receive a course offer at La Trobe, or be currently enrolled in a La Trobe degree.
- Reside, or intend to reside, at a La Trobe University residential accommodation facility.

KEY TERMS

THERE'S A LOT TO LEARN AT UNI – INCLUDING HOW TO TALK ABOUT IT.

HERE'S THE MEANING OF SOME KEY WORDS AND PHRASES WE USE IN THIS GUIDE.

ADJUSTMENT FACTORS

Adjustment factors are additional factors we consider in your application based on your personal circumstances and performance. Adjustment factors may be added to your raw ATAR.

ADVANCED STANDING

If you've completed relevant and formally recognised studies at another uni or TAFE, or have suitable work experience, you may get advanced standing (also known as 'credit') towards a qualification. This means you may finish your course faster.

ASPIRE ATAR

The Aspire ATAR is the score you need to lock in your conditional offer. It's an adjusted ATAR that is different to the regular ATAR listed on the course pages.

You may be eligible for an Aspire ATAR if you're applying for an Aspire Early Entry Program.

AUSTRALIAN TERTIARY ADMISSIONS RANK (ATAR)

A number between 0.00 and 99.95 to rank your Year 12 results against other students' results.

COMMONWEALTH SUPPORTED PLACE (CSP)

When you're offered a CSP, the government subsidises your course fees and you only need to pay for part of your tuition, known as the 'student contribution amount'. All domestic undergraduate places at La Trobe are CSPs.

EARLY ENTRY PROGRAMS

Early entry programs give you an alternative way to get into your dream course by considering factors like community contribution, achieving good results in Year 11 or taking extra uni studies.

Early entry programs at La Trobe include the Aspire Early Entry Programs, the Tertiary Preparation Program (TPP), and Rise with La Trobe.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Each course has different requirements to be granted entry. These requirements are usually made up of qualifications, subjects or exam grades. Course prerequisites and other extra requirements, such as interviews and portfolios, can be found at latrobe.edu.au/courses

HONOURS

Honours studies are advanced studies attached to undergraduate degrees that give you a higher qualification than a three-year degree. Many people do Honours so they can continue to postgraduate studies.

Depending on your course, this may involve an additional year of study, though some courses have it built in.

INDUSTRY PLACEMENTS

Also known as Work Based Learning (WBL) or Work Integrated Learning (WIL), an industry placement is a combination of educational theory in the classroom plus real-world experience in a workplace.

MAJOR

A major is a way to specialise in your course. It's made up of a sequence of related subjects spread over the duration of an undergraduate course. You'll usually take at least one subject from your major each semester, and you need to pass each subject to move onto the next one in the sequence.

PATHWAYS

Pathways help you enter your chosen course through another qualification. For example, the Diploma of Arts is a pathway to the Bachelor of Arts. Going from Year 12 to TAFE and then to uni is another. You can also start a related La Trobe degree and apply to transfer into your preferred degree later.

PREREQUISITES

Prerequisites are subjects you must have previously completed to be eligible for consideration for a particular uni course.

SCORED/UNSCORED VCE

A scored VCE program gives you an ATAR and requires you to complete coursework and exams for at least four subjects. In the unscored VCE option, you complete the VCE coursework but don't sit exams, and aren't given an ATAR.

STUDY SCORE

This shows how well you performed in Units 3 and 4 of a subject compared to everyone else in Victoria who took the subject. The mean study score is 30, above 38 puts you in the top 15% and the maximum study score is 50.

VET

Vocational Education and Training.

WEIGHTED AVERAGE MARK (WAM)

The calculation we use instead of the grade point average (GPA).

We calculate your WAM by using:
