Position Context

Nangak Tamboree Wildlife Sanctuary is positioned within the Environmental Sustainability Unit.

The Sanctuary is the Outdoor Laboratory of the University. It is a 50 year bushland regeneration project focused on the conservation and biodiversity of indigenous wildlife*. This provides research, teaching and learning and other engagement opportunities for the university and the wider community.

Reporting to the Visitor Experiences Coordinator, Education Presenters are responsible for providing effective and efficient delivery of a range of educational experiences for primary and secondary school students. Presenters also provide support for University use, bookings of our facilities and tours for the general public.

Education Presenters will be enthusiastic and clear communicators with the capacity to engage and educate students and their teachers about sustainability and conservation issues. They will be part of a team that cooperatively organise all aspects of the day's preparation, activities and clean up at the conclusion. They will participate in a range of evaluation programs designed to continuously improve the learning experiences and activities offered at the Wildlife Sanctuary.

We are currently looking to increase our pool of casual Education Presenters.

**Please note: We are a true wildlife sanctuary (not a zoo), as such this position does not include and animal handling or interaction.*

Duties include:

- Facilitation of learning and education experiences to primary and secondary school students, varying from ages 5 – 17 years.
- Representing La Trobe University and the Nangak Tamboree Wildlife Sanctuary in a positive and professional way.
- Responding appropriately to questions; providing a high level of customer service.
- Actively attend and participate in scheduled trainings, meetings and induction sessions through the year.
- Provide a safe and engaging environment to facilitate good learning outcomes.
- Participate in evaluation strategies to improve the education experiences and programs run by the Wildlife Sanctuary.
- Set up, pack up and maintain equipment used in experiences.

Skills and Experience

Suitable applicants will have:

- Completed, or undertaking qualifications in Science (biology-related) and/or Education.
- Excellent public speaking skills with an ability to engage with a variety of learners and learning styles.
- Demonstrated high-level written and verbal communication skills, with the ability to liaise with diverse groups, including members of the public, teachers, University staff, senior management, administrative staff and academics.
- Able to work autonomously and adapt to changing situations.
- Able to operate effectively in a team, contributing positively to team operations and working relationships.
- Familiarity with local flora and fauna and interconnectedness within an ecosystem.
