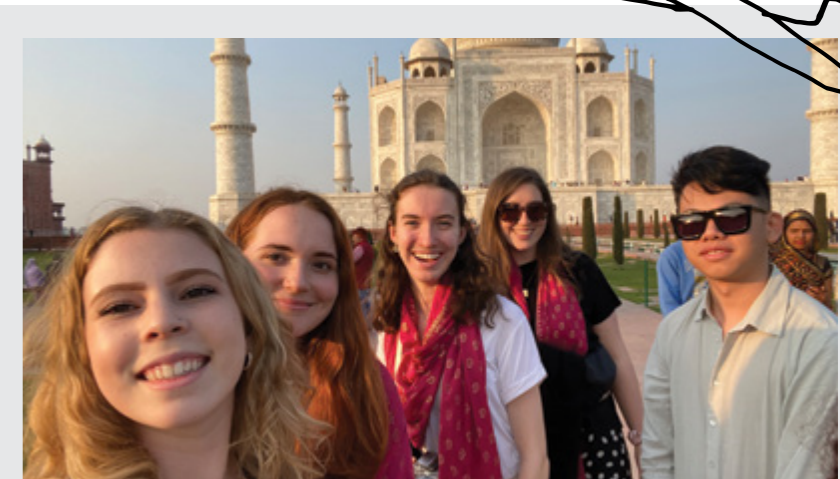

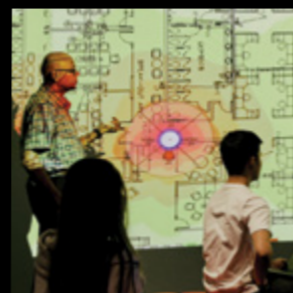
Study abroad

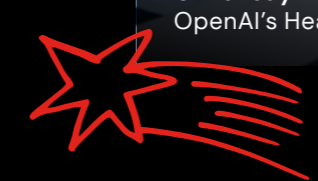

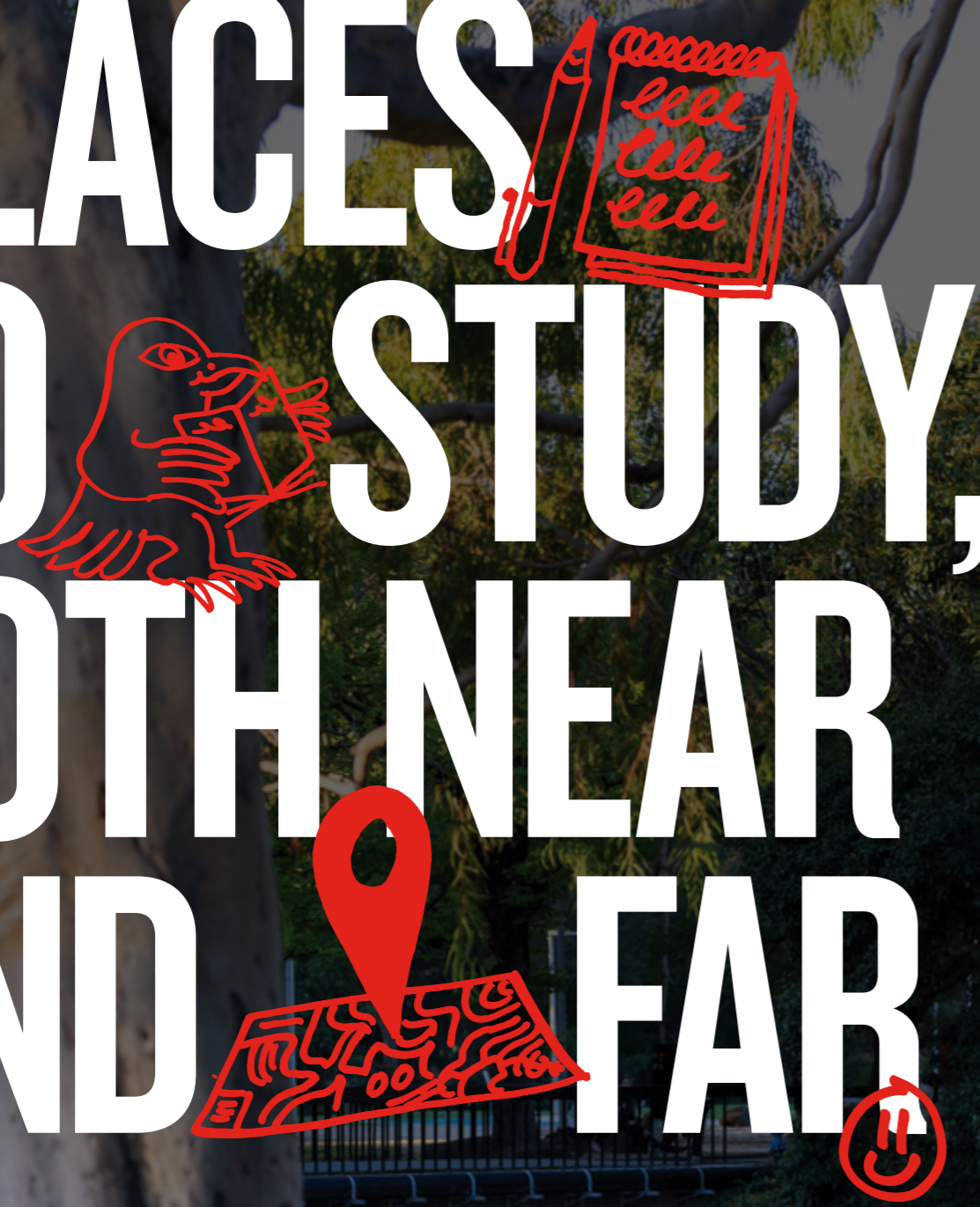

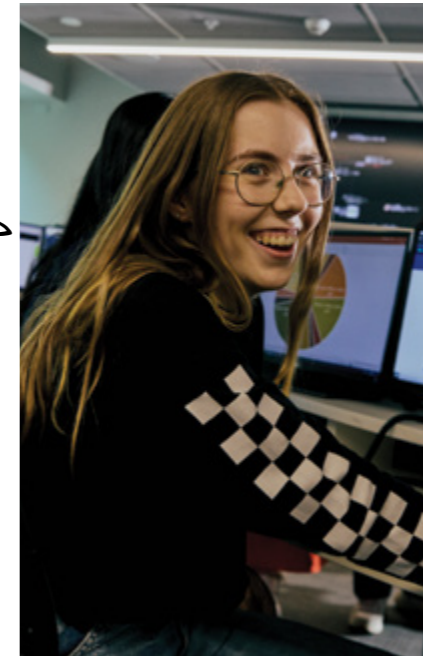
Campus life and events

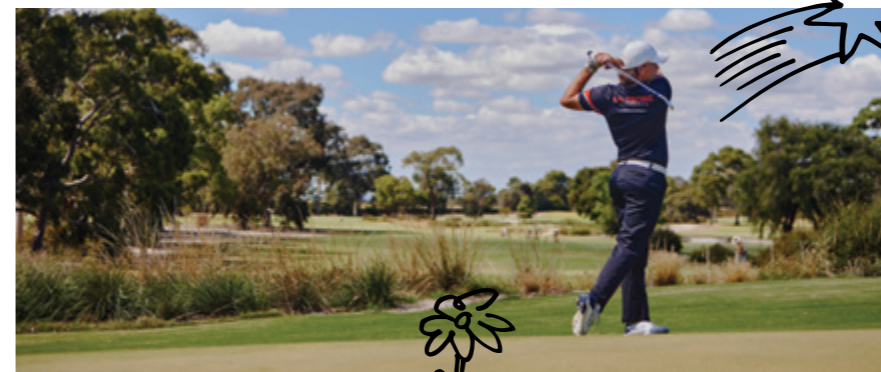
Clubs, societies and student organisations

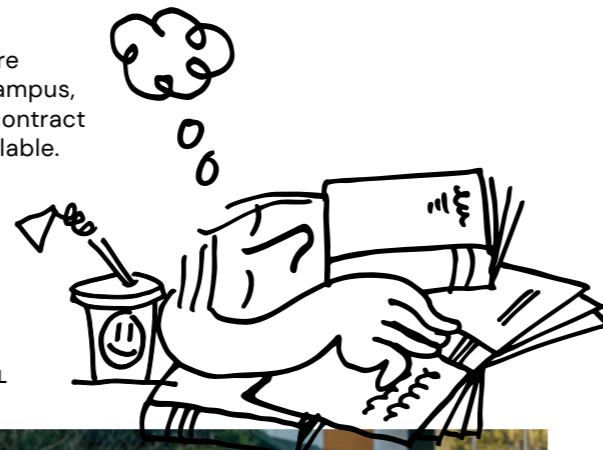

PATHWAYS

Pathways

If you didn't get the ATAR you wanted, or you aren't ready to start a degree right away, a great option is to start a pathway course then transfer later, provided you meet the entry requirements.

Some of our pathway options¹ include:

- Studying a different Bachelor's degree with lower entry requirements then transferring
- Studying a two-year Associate Degree with lower entry requirements then transferring
- Studying a one-year Diploma then using that credit to transfer into an eligible Bachelor's degree
- Completing a certificate or diploma at TAFE or VET then transferring
- Studying a diploma or certificate at La Trobe College and getting second year entry into a Bachelor's degree without an ATAR.

Navigating university

The student advising team are your first stop for support options and campus services to make you feel welcome at La Trobe. Your student advisor can connect you to many of the services we offer, such as wellbeing, career, and learning support, clubs, financial counselling, and more. You can also match with a peer mentor, which is an experienced student who will help you navigate your first six weeks of uni – the perfect amount of time to help you find your feet.



Learning support

If you need that extra boost to help you prepare for uni, your student advisor can connect you to specific learning support and library services. These include peer learning advisors, academic skills advisors, after-class tutorial support, or specific study skills workshops and resources. Plus, if you have any challenges that impact your ability to study, the student advising team can connect you to services.

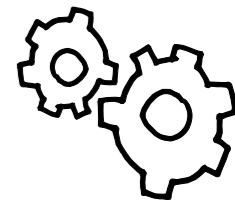

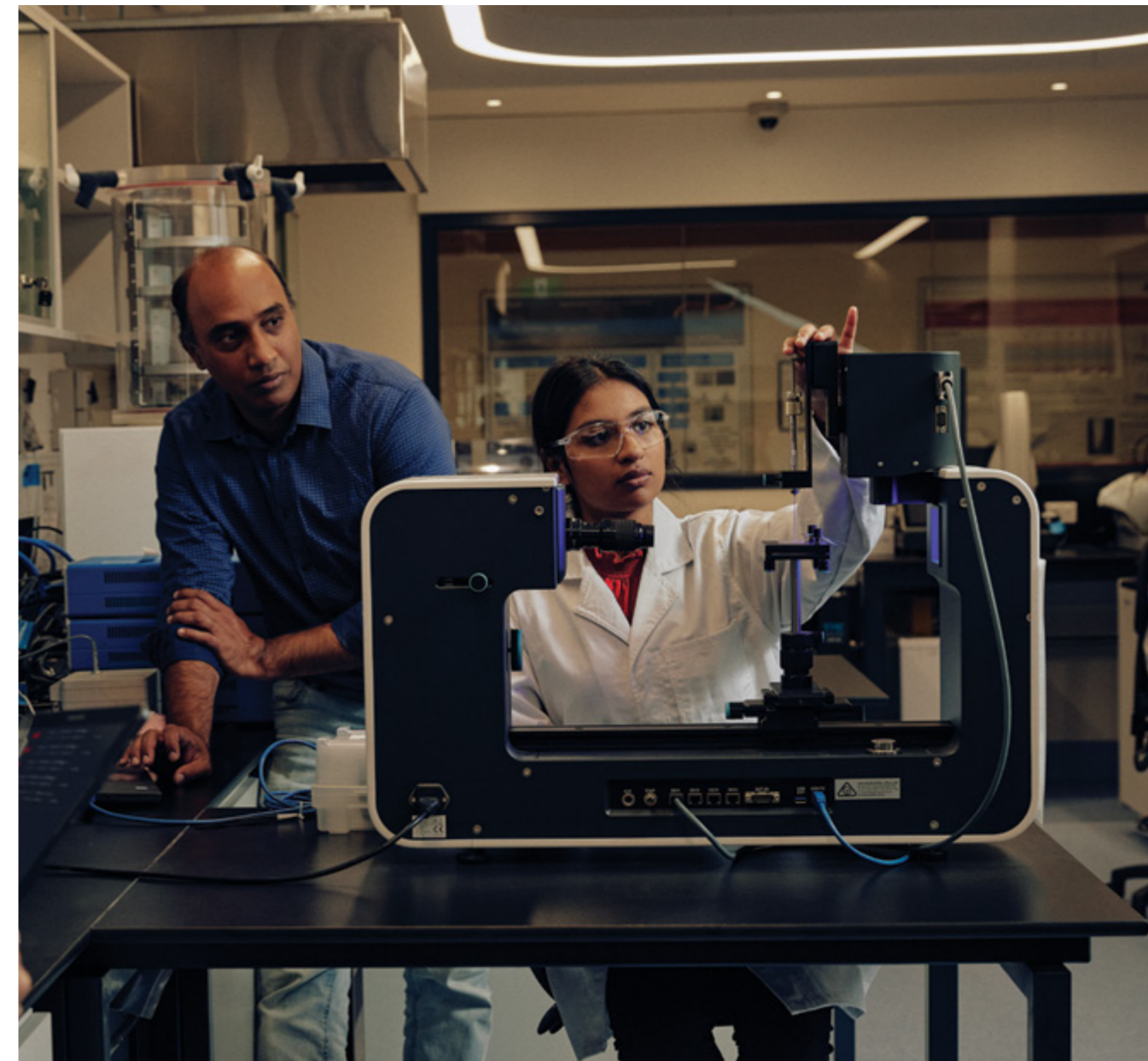

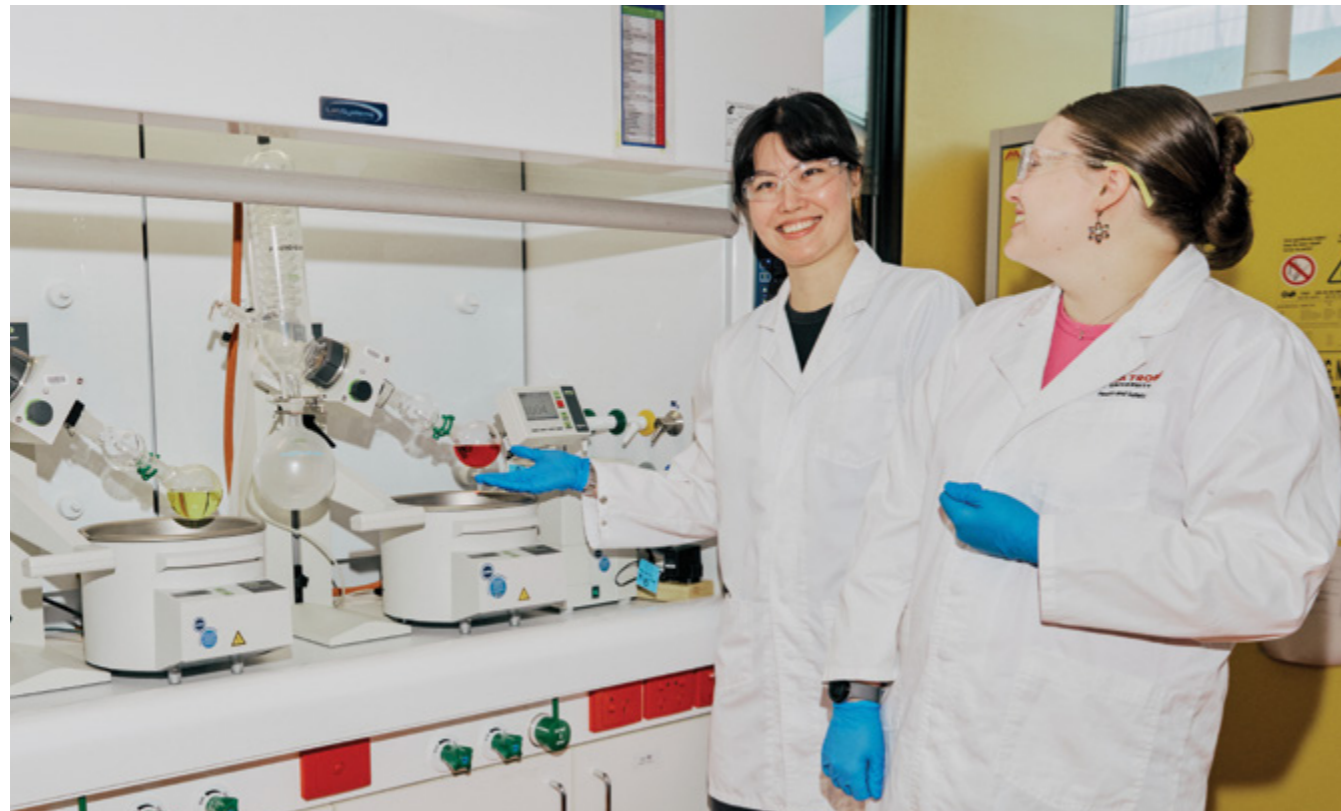
