<b>Nomination procedure</b>	The home university shall nominate their students through an online form (link sent in email to partner universities) no later than 1 April for Autumn and 1 October for Spring.
<b>Malmö University Semesters</b>	Autumn 2021: 30 August 2021 - 16 January 2022 Spring 2022: 17 January 2022 – 5 June 2022
<b>Arrival Day and Introduction Programme</b>	<p>Arrival Day for international students is approximately one week prior to the official semester start, followed by an introduction programme. Arrival Day Autumn Semester : 19 August 2021 Arrival Day Spring Semester: TBA</p> <p>Arrival day check-in hours: 09.00 - 17.00 We recommend all exchange students to arrive during the official Arrival Day. <b>Letter of Acceptance</b>	After Malmö University has received and processed the application a formal Letter of Acceptance will be sent via email to the student (home university coordinator on cc.). The Letter of Acceptance is usually not sent before application deadline
<b>Transcript of Records</b>	The Transcript of Records will be sent via email to the student (home university coordinator on cc.).
<b>Insurance Information</b>	All incoming exchange students are covered for accidents, liability and legal expenses through the Swedish State's Insurance for Foreign Students in Sweden: <a href="#">Student IN Insurance</a> .  EU/EEA citizens are covered for emergency medical and dental care through their European Health Insurance Card. The card shall be brought to Sweden from the home country.
<b>Swedish Language Course</b>	All exchange students are offered a language course during the Introduction Programme at Malmö University.
