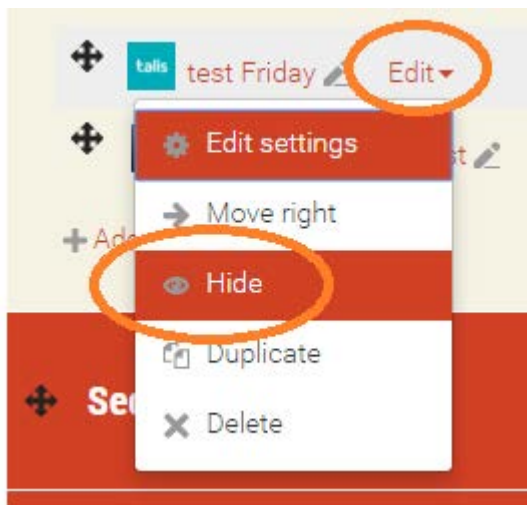


## Embedding Reading Lists in Moodle Books

Audience: Library L&T Staff and Ed Tech Staff

1. Embed a new reading list, as per the normal process, into the Moodle section (week)
  - Embed the reading list as 'On a separate page'
2. Once embedded, hide the reading list by
  - Click on the 'Edit' button
  - Select 'Hide'



3. Click on the reading list link, you've just created (and hidden)
  - You'll be taken to a new Moodle page with the embedded list
4. Copy the URL
  - The URL should look like this:
  - <https://lms.latrobe.edu.au/mod/aspirelists/view.php?id=1953413>
5. Paste this URL in a text editor (ie notepad)
6. Replace the word "view" with "launch"
  - Eg <https://lms.latrobe.edu.au/mod/aspirelists/launch.php?id=1953413>

7. Go to the Moodle book, in edit mode
8. Click on the icon named "Edit HTML Source"
  - The icon looks like this "<>"
9. Make a copy of the HTML and paste in a new text editor file (just in case the next step fails)
10. Find the place within the Moodle Book you want to embed the list and paste the following text:

```
<hr><p><span style="font-size: 13.6px; line-height: 1.4;"> Reading
List</span></p>
```

```
<p><iframe src="ENTER URL HERE" width="100%" height="400px"
frameborder="0"></iframe></p><hr>
```

11. Replace the text "ENTER URL HERE" with the URL you pasted in the text editor
  - Ensure the quotation marks are not deleted
12. Click the "Update" button
13. Click the "Save Changes" button
14. Check that the reading list has been embedded into the moodle book, as per your expectations.
