Dr Guinever Threlkeld has held a number of senior leadership positions at La Trobe University. Dr Threlkeld has led the University's Albury-Wodonga campus since 2013. In this time, she has deepened the University's relationships with schools and Wodonga Institute of TAFE, local government, business, and community, and persistently advocated for sustainable higher education delivery in regional Victoria. Her research and consultancy work focuses on accessible and effective models of delivery for health and human services in rural and regional communities.

Dr Threlkeld is also the Director of TAFE Partnerships. The Director of TAFE Partnerships plays a pivotal role in fostering strong collaborations between La Trobe University and TAFEs throughout metropolitan and regional Victoria collaborating with the Pro Vice-Chancellor Educational Partnerships to deliver La Trobe University's international and domestic educational partnership strategy. As a member of the Senior Leadership Group and key member of the Executive team of the Pro Vice-Chancellor (Regional), this position is a university wide leadership role designed to advance the institution's mission of providing diverse and accessible educational opportunities to students while strengthening ties with the broader education community.

Dr Threlkeld is currently a member of the Equity in Higher Education Panel (appointed by and advising the Federal Minister for Education and Youth); Director Gateway Health; member of the Board of Murray Art Museum Albury; and a member of the Albury-Wodonga Health Ethics Committee.
